These questions were used as part of the screening process...

* When general elections are held in the United States, how often do you vote?

- If all of the time, press 1
- If most of the time, press 2
- If about half the time, press 3
- If occasionally, press 4 [THANK YOU and GOOD-BYE]
- If rarely or never, press 5 [THANK YOU and GOOD-BYE]
- If you are not sure, press 6 [THANK YOU and GOOD-BYE]

* How closely have you followed the Presidential debates and other campaign activities so far?

If very closely, press 1.

If somewhat closely, press 2.

If not very closely, press 3.

If not at all, press 4.

If you are not sure, press 5.

* How likely are you to vote in the New Hampshire Primary?

If very likely, press 1.

If somewhat likely, press 2.

If not very likely, press 3.

If not at all likely, press 4.

If you are not sure, press 5.

* Have you ever voted in the New Hampshire Primary before?

If yes, press 1.

If no, press 2.

If you are not sure, press 3.

* Many times, things come up that make it impossible for someone to vote in the primaries. Are you certain that you will vote in the Michigan primary or is it possible that something might come up to prevent you from voting?

If certain, press 1.

If something might come up, press 2.

If you are not sure, press 3.
