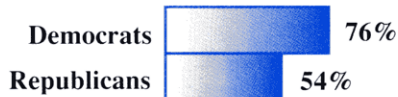


International Conflict, the Presidency, and Party ID

Oppose

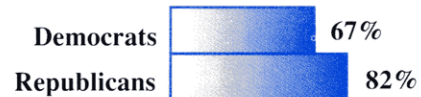

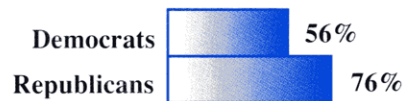

Disapprove

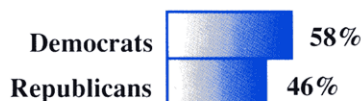

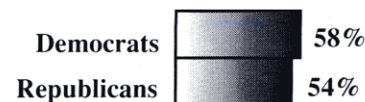
Nixon (R)
