
CLINTON'S FIRST 100 DAYS

Bill Clinton, elected with 43 percent of the vote, does not fare as well as his recent predecessors did at the 100 day mark. Particularly noteworthy are the numbers who disapprove of his performance, comparable at this time only to the disapproval ratings of Gerald Ford, who had just pardoned Richard Nixon, a highly unpopular move.
