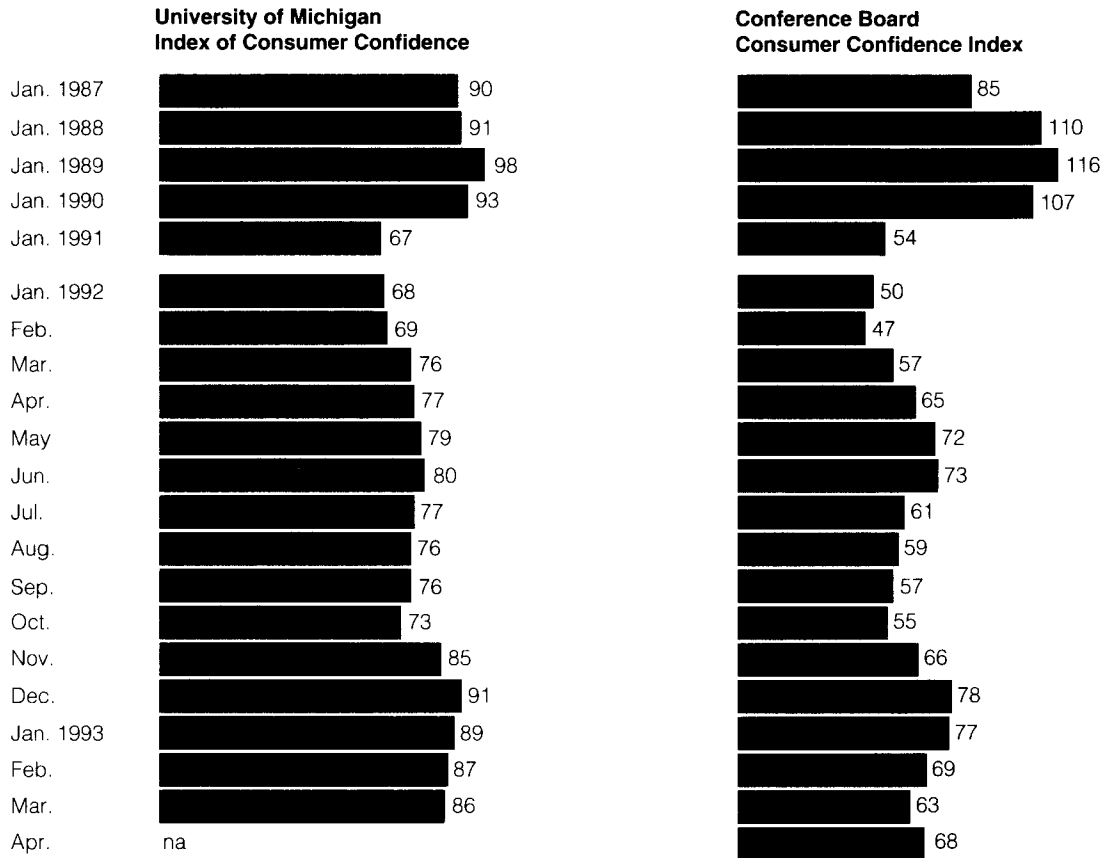


CONSUMER CONFIDENCE

After showing some recovery in late 1992 and early 1993, consumer confidence numbers have slipped some. Ratings of Clinton's handling of the economy and confidence in his economic plan are hovering around the majority mark.
