






Christmas: We Celebrate It in Many Ways

Question: Which holiday is the most significant Christian holiday to you personally?




Question: Which of the following activities, if any, do you participate usually in during the Christmas season...?



Question: ... Would you say that you hear too much, the right amount, or too little non-religious Christmas music over the Christmas season?










Christmas: On the Religious Dimension We Show Commitment—and Anxiety






Question: ...Do you think...[Christmas] is a more religious than commercial holiday or more commercial than religious?




Christmas: Yes to Governmental Recognition




Question: Which of the following, if any, do you or other members of your household do for your dog [cat]...?

Asked of respondents who own one or more cats (31%)







Give Pet Toys or Presents?



Christmas Can Be a Lonely Time of the Year for Me








